**AFJA Trophy Series** The final event for 2007 will be held at Wakefield Park NSW in November where our annual trophies for the most consistent drivers will be awarded at a dinner meeting on the Saturday evening in Goulburn. We have advised the HSRCA that we expect a larger than normal entry of Formula Junior cars, and have suggested that separate races for FJ/F3 should be considered for the program. See details re this weekend elsewhere in this issue.

**2008 Junior Tasman Series** As part of the world wide celebration for the 50<sup>th</sup> year of Formula Junior, the AFJA have combined with the NZFJR to organise a series of events in both countries, commencing with January 26-27 at Pukekohe near Auckland, February 1-3 at Taupo central north island, March 1-2 at Calder Raceway Vic. with the final on March 7-9 at Phillip Island. To date there are 38 Australian cars expected to contest the local events, and it is possible there are enough cars to fill four 40 Ft containers for competition in NZ.

During the past month contestants should have received 4 emails from the AFJA requesting information necessary for the organization of the series, namely, we require asap

- Copy of your cars Certificate of Description, or application for same.
- Advice re type of CAMS racing licence currently held, and update arrangements if any.
- Height of cars roll bar from ground, if considering events in NZ.

Contestants and their crew will need to arrange accommodation in NZ, especially near the Taupo circuit where it will be at a premium, as it could also be at Phillip Island during the long weekend in Vic. We also need to know which cars need to be garaged in Vic. between Tasman events and round one of the AFJA Trophy Series at Mallala SA 2 weeks after Phillip Island.

**Committee Report** The AFJA committee have adopted By-Laws to assist with management of the Association that are identical to those proposed to members in March this year, together with an additional arrangement to facilitate committee meetings via the internet.

#### AUSTRALIAN FORMULA JUNIOR TROPHY SERIES

During 2007 members were given the opportunity to contest 7 rounds in 4 different states of Australia, and currently after 6 rounds, with one to go, there are 5 cars that have entered 4 of these events, 3 of which could win the coveted AFJA Leo Geoghegan FJ Trophy, as Jonathan Williamson leads Don Thallon by just one point, and should either stumble at Wakefield in the final round, Mike Gosbell could upset their applecart.

The Aon Trophy presented by Geoff Fry & Associates to the Australian built Formula Junior with the highest point score has been won by Mike Gosbell in the Donford (provided he does not win the AFJA Trophy) and he is to be congratulated for his consistent driving during the Series.

To date there are no contenders for the Nereo Dizane F3 Trophy, as most of the cars that comply with this Formula are currently under restoration, and not expected to appear before 2008, but then should a car race at Wakefield in November, it could win the first trophy.

The AFJA committee have had some preliminary discussions regarding the Trophy Series for 2008, and it is possible that there will be only 4 events for the series encompassing Mallala, Winton, Morgan Park and Wakefield Park in that order, as there will be other major events at the beginning and end of the year connected with cross Tasman competition in Vic. and NSW.

#### RACE REPORT - MORGAN PARK - ROUND FIVE AFJA TROPHY SERIES

The Queensland Historic Racing Car Club's major annual race meeting has in past years been held at Queensland Raceway, but rapidly rising costs at that venue necessitated a move to the 'country' circuit at Warwick. This was no great loss to the Formula Junior peddlers as Morgan Park is far more suited to these cars and with newly laid tarmac, lap times have dramatically tumbled this year despite the less competitive Dunlop 'L' tyres.

On a fine sunny weekend the eleven Formula Junior cars entered for the meeting were rewarded by the promoters with a feature race on the Sunday but in other races were mixed with various groups of J,K,L,M, O, and V cars depending on the 130% rule or grid capacity limits. On the Saturday this unfortunately had the three slowest of the juniors in one race with the remainder competing two races later. The three in the first group was further diluted by the withdrawal of Mike Goodfellow (Talisman) with engine problems leaving Geoff Fry (Jolus) to compete with Alan Conway (Gemini MK 3A) for the FJ honors with Geoff prevailing. Don Thallon (Cooper BMC) was absent from the subsequent race with engine problems while Peter Strauss (Brabham BT 6) had retired from the meeting with drive shaft failure leaving Roger Ealand (Lotus 18) to lead the way from pole position with Peter Boel (Lola MK 5A), and Mike Gosbell (Donford) in hot pursuit. These three competed in close company for the lead for most of the race but greeted the chequered flag in that order. Further back David Reid (Cooper T59) just managed to hold off Graham Brown (Brabham BT2) to the line with Alan Telfer (Lotus 20B) further back in the field.

The Sunday FJ feature race had 9 entrants with Don Thallon (Cooper BMC) returning to the field with a properly functioning motor. Roger Ealand (Lotus 18) again took the lead from pole with Peter Boel (Lola MK5A) and Don Thallon (Cooper BMC) in close pursuit. Don overtook Peter at the back of the circuit and these two closely contested second position until Peter spun off on the second last corner of the last lap. Meanwhile Roger Ealand easily maintained the lead to the chequered flag. Further back Graham Brown (Brabham BT2) retired early with a broken universal joint leaving Mike Gosbell (Donford) to take third from David Reid (Cooper T59) and a recovering Peter Boel. Geoff Fry (Jolus) and Alan Conway (Gemini MK3A) followed in that order after a close race long tussle and Alan Telfer (Lotus 20B) brought the field home.

Despite some confusion over the running order I think most of the FJ competitors enjoyed the meeting and its success probably means Morgan Park will remain the venue for all future HRCC meetings.

Regret to inform that Noel Barnes from Tamworth NSW a long time member of the AFJA and owner of the ex Jon Leighton Lotus 20 for many years, died in April earlier this year, and on behalf of the members we offer our sympathy to his family.

Had a call recently from Howard Tucker in NSW when he advised of his progress in restoring the ex Bruce Powell Lynx Ford that Peter Wherrett used to drive, Howard has returned the car back to its Formula Junior spec's, and we look forward to seeing it in new livery in the near future.
