



AUSTRALIAN FORMULA JUNIOR TROPHY SERIES YEAR 2007

Don Thallon driving his T56 Cooper BMC gained a perfect score to win the AFJA Annual Perpetual Trophy after a close tussle with Jonathan Williamson in his Lotus 22, and Mike Gosbell secured the ANON annual trophy for the best Aust built car, unfortunately, the Nereo Dizane memorial F3 trophy was not contested this year, but in 2008 there are now 9 of these cars in the country, and we expect some competition in the near future.

The annual trophy series is the only means that the AFJA have to ensure that all cars comply with the original Formula Junior Regulations, as the CAMS Historic Commission have refused our previous applications to create a separate group in lieu of the existing groups L and M based on year of manufacture.

During the year we experienced some difficulty at certain high profile events where Formula Juniors were mixed with high performance Group O cars, this unfortunately caused the withdrawal from the meeting of our slower cars due to the 130% rule, and our members had no recourse in the matter, so as a direct result, the Committee have decided to reduce the number of events contested, and promote those that will cater for our Formula to the exclusion of others



In late December John sold the car to Kim Shearn also from Vic. who will drive it for the first time in rounds 3 and 4 of the Junior Tasman series, after arranging for his friend Norm Falkiner to drive it in the NZ rounds 1 and 2. Welcome to Formula Junior Kim.

Patrick Ryan from Vic. advised that he expects to complete the restoration of his Brabham BT15 F3 car for competition in 2008, and we look forward to observing it on the track in the near future. Pat also owns the Cameron MK3 that complies with Formula Junior Regulations, and he informs us that this car will also be seen shortly in the hands of a young driver, who is currently finishing its restoration.

Bill Hemming completed the restoration of his Elfin Formula Junior before Christmas, just in time to test it at Winton Raceway before loading it into the shipping container for its journey to NZ, and the first rounds of the Junior Tasman Series.

Ed Holly from NSW advised that he is removing the twin cam from his BT15 Brabham F3, and reinstating the original 1 litre engine for 2008, which is great news for the F3 Trophy Series, and we are also informed that there is a possibility that Jeff Brown from Vic who bought the BT28 Brabham F3 from Robert Foster could be a starter at the Tasman Revival in Nov. at Eastern Creek.
