2010 AFJA ANNUAL TROPHY SERIES

There were seven rounds of the annual trophy series during 2010, and Peter Strauss from Victoria finally won the coveted Australian Formula junior Leo Geoghegan Perpetual Trophy after many attempts, with a final maximum score of 80 points driving his Brabham BT6 Formula Junior.

The AON Aussie car trophy donated by Geoff Fry and Associates was awarded to Don Thallon from Qld. Driving his Australian built MRC Lotus Formula Junior in a year when his luck was surely tested with various mechanical maladies.

Unfortunately, the Nereo Dizane Memorial Perpetual Trophy for Formula 3 cars was not contested during 2010, and subsequently not presented; however, there is every indication that there will be cars competing for this trophy in 2011 when certain car restorations are completed.

TASMAN REVIVAL BIANNUAL HISTORIC MEETING AT EASTERN CREEK NSW

Congratulations to the HSRCA Race Committee for organizing such a spectacular event, and to AFJA President Roger for his persistent pursuit of members to be part of this three day event held November 26-28. Over 40 FJ/F3 cars were entered to form a separate grid, 25% of these were overseas cars from NZ, Japan and USA to make our events more interesting, and to record the largest grid of Australian FJ/F3 cars ever.

Formula Junior cars were housed in a large marquee in the pit area where we had heaps of advertising including the recent release of a very professional AFJA brochure subsidized by "Peter Larner Engines", and designed by President Roger. The temperature during the long weekend was sultry/humid exceeding 30 deg .c, and this made our exclusive upstairs airconditioned hospitality suite beneficial for members and guests where we all enjoyed lunch together. It also provided a great venue for the presentation of our annual perpetual trophies on Friday evening..

During the long weekend we enjoyed 4 races, one Friday, two Saturday, and a special event on Sunday that was unfortunately upset by rain. It was great to see the Pymble BT6 back on the track in FJ guise, and Simon who drove it very responsibly, regained his lap record status with a 1-51.0882 which is 1/10 of a second faster than the record posted by Jonathan Williamson in 2007, who was 6 sec per lap off his previous best time during the weekend.

The overall winner during the weekend was David Methley from the UK who drove President Roger's Lotus 18 to glory, which put a few noses out of joint when you consider this car was built in 1960, and showed over the weekend the lack of performance by much later cars. It was great to see four cars from WA including the recently restored Elfin of Bruce Edgar on their way to NZ for events in January.

Some of the interesting incidents over the weekend included Peter Strauss loosing a tyre valve in race one when he came too close to another car in turn two. Jeff Brown damaged the gearbox on his BT28 and became a spectator, whilst Kim Shearn had similar problems, but installed his spare transmission overnight, David Reid had some annoying problems with carby linkage on the T59, and Geoff McInnes had problems with faulty fuel in the Lynx.

It was great to see Max Lane enjoying himself in his new Lola Mk2 front engine car recently bought from England, but unfortunately, like most new cars there was a problem with the engine that will need to be addressed. Bill Hemming suffered some health problem requiring him to quit racing on Saturday, Norm Falkiner damaged the clutch fork on the Stanguellini and worked overnight to repair it, but Mike Gosbell was most unlucky when a valve seized in his new engine and possibly damaged a piston.

The overall results are published elsewhere in this publication, and more details are available from the Natsoft website. Overall it was a great meeting, and it is hoped we can repeat this at Phillip Island in March 2011
